- **Whole class teaching can be delivered in partnership with your school or as a stand-alone programme with Coventry Music tutors.**
- **Sessions are delivered over 33 agreed weeks and focus on developing the wider musician in line with the National Plan for Music Education 2022 whilst developing skills on a principal instrument.**
- **To ensure good progress is made two adults are needed in the space. This can be two Coventry Music tutors or a school staff member to embed the programme further.**
- **Charanga Music Professional is provided for all our tutors alongside some other digital resources where rooms/spaces are suitable for this technology to be used.**



WHOLE CLASS HOURLY PROVISION

Hourly provision to cover larger group programmes of over 10 students

For programmes lasting over 1 term instruments will be included where appropriate.

- Progression group (over 10 students)





MUSIC CURRICULUM DELIVERY

- Curriculum music lessons follow the national curriculum and are designed to build on the School's Music Development Plan.
- These sessions include - Listening, Singing, Composition, and the History of music – all whilst using appropriate instruments and technology to fit the abilities of the class.
- Our team also have access to Charanga and Sparkyard resources to support the lessons alongside your classroom instruments.
- Specialist equipment is available when required.



➤ LIVE PERFORMANCES

- Professional musicians and young people from the city performing live in your school.
- Ask for more details of our current offers.

MUSIC TUITION

TEACHING OF STUDENTS TO PLAY AN INSTRUMENT OR USE THEIR VOICE

1:1 or small group teaching for a minimum of 20 minutes per lesson on one instrument/voice.

A tutor needs to be in the school for a minimum of 1 hour.*



Free Provision for LAC students funded by the Virtual School



Curriculum work is delivered in line with schools' own curriculum plans or thematic/topic-based schemes of work. Coventry Music staff work alongside school staff to create and audit a School Music Development Plan, demonstrating how music is embedded into the whole school curriculum.

➤ SINGING FESTIVALS

- Take part in our FREE Singing Festivals for KS1 and KS2 – hosted at a central Coventry venue.
- These events feature a live band and music written by professional composers and educators to match the voices of the young people taking part.
- Optional CPD and one school visit* are available to support learning alongside guide tracks, PowerPoints and wider curriculum resources.



➤ STAFF TRAINING/CPD

ORGANISED BY COVENTRY MUSIC IN A CENTRAL LOCATION

Our new CPD programme will include:

- Access to up to 4 staff per school per session to attend 3 x 2-hour programmes
- School Music Development Plan writing support & assessment,
- Further bespoke training to fit the needs raised by schools.

BESPOKE CPD IN YOUR SCHOOL

- Training delivered in your school to your whole team.
- This can focus on specific aspects of music teaching through to fun experience workshops and team building activities.
- All resources will be provided or the equipment in school can be used to design easily replicable teaching activities.

PROJECTS & EXTRAS

➤ SCHOOL MUSIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN

To support your school's learning outcomes by implementing a School Music Development Plan.

This includes an initial and end meeting with development work taking place in between.

➤ CURRICULUM MAPPING

To build on your school music development plan.

This also includes 3 hours of additional support in school to ensure that the curriculum plans of your school link closely with your music curriculum – including suggestions of resources and topic links.

A whole school map will be provided which will thread music into your thematic curriculum.

➤ CURRICULUM PLANNING

The equivalent of two days per key stage to create mid-term plans for a whole academic year to incorporate the existing scheme used by the school alongside music activities that match topics and themes, books poems, science, etc.

Plans could be linked to Charanga and Sparkyard which are available at a subsidised rate through Coventry Music. In addition, assessment criteria will be provided at the end of each half or full term of music lessons to match with the Model Music Curriculum skill expectations written in a non-specialist friendly format.
