WHOLE CLASS INSTRUMENTAL TEACHING (WCIT)

- Whole class teaching can be delivered in partnership with your school or as a stand-alone programme with Coventry Music tutors.
- Sessions are delivered over 33 agreed weeks and focus on developing the wider musician in line with the National Plan for Music Education 2022, whilst developing skills on a principal instrument.
- To ensure good progress is made two adults are needed in the space. This can be two Coventry Music tutors or a school staff member to embed the programme further.
- Charanga Music Professional is provided for all our tutors alongside bespoke digital resources to support learning.



➤ SINGING OPPORTUNITIES

- Take part in our Singing Festivals for KS1 and KS2 – hosted at a central Coventry venue with capacity for an audience or in a school.
- These events will often feature a live band. In smaller venues, we will use professionally recorded backing tracks as the accompaniment led by one of the Coventry Music vocal leaders. The music is written by professional composers and educators to match the voices of the young people taking part.
- Optional CPD and one school visit are available to support learning alongside guide tracks, PowerPoints and wider curriculum resources. Some of which are from the Sparkyard scheme.

Curriculum work is delivered in line with schools' own curriculum plans or thematic/topic-based schemes of work.

Coventry Music staff work alongside school staff to create and audit a School Music Development Plan, demonstrating how music is embedded into the whole school curriculum.

- Curriculum music lessons follow the national curriculum and are designed to build on the School's Music Development Plan.
- These sessions include - Listening, Singing, Composition, and the History of music - all whilst using appropriate instruments and technology to fit the abilities of the class.
- Our team also have access to Charanga and Sparkyard resources to support the lessons alongside your classroom instruments.
- Specialist equipment is available when required.



MUSIC TUITION


TEACHING OF STUDENTS TO PLAY AN INSTRUMENT OR USE THEIR VOICE
